INFORMATION LETTER

On November 16-17, 2023, Baku State University will host the 1st International Scientific Conference on the topic "The Turkic World: a common history - cultural values, modern realities and a vision of the future". The scientific conference is held to implement the "Action Plan" of the Ministry of Science and Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan on the announcement of the city of Shusha "Cultural Capital of the Turkic World in 2023" dated 28.02.2023 on the basis of the order 3 29/3 - 2 - 78 F/2023 included in the action plan for 2023 of the Faculty of History of Baku State University. Faculty, researchers, doctoral students and dissertators are invited to participate in the conference. We look forward to new and interesting research from valuable researchers at the conference.

Conference topics:

- The history of the statehood of the Turkic peoples in the context of the general Turkic history
- Place of Azerbaijan in the history of the Turkic world
- Turkic world: common historical and cultural values
- The Turkic world in the 21st century: modern realities and vision of the future
- A new stage of cooperation between the Turkic states - the creation and activities of the Organization of Turkic States
- General history and cultural values of the Turkic peoples in scientific works and examples of fiction
- Territorial claims of Armenia to Azerbaijan: territorial conflicts, historical falsifications, media war
- The Significance and Results of the Victory in the 44-day Patriotic War for the General Turkic History

- Historical, material and cultural monuments of the city of Shusha, the cultural capital of the Turkic world and their restoration
- Return from occupation of Karabakh and Eastern Zangezur. Construction and restoration work
- Political, economic and cultural relations between the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Republic of Türkiye during the years of independence
- Political, economic and cultural relations of the Republic of Azerbaijan with the Republics of Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan, Turkmenistan during the years of independence

General Principles:

- Topics submitted to the conference should correspond to the theme of the conference;
- The main working language of the conference is Azerbaijani, but reports will be sent in other Turkic dialects, English and Russian;
- Abstracts are accepted in Azerbaijani, other Turkish dialects, English and Russian (with translation into English; for reports in English with translation into Azerbaijani);
- Abstracts recognized as plagiarism are not accepted for consideration;
- Abstracts submitted to the conference are accepted after receiving a positive conclusion from the Scientific Committee;
- Next to the surname of young authors who do not have an academic degree or academic title, the name of the supervisor, academic title, academic degree and e-mail address should be indicated. Feedback from supervisors must be scanned and attached to the letter. The supervisor and the author are responsible for the reliability of the materials and the originality of the study;
- Abstracts that do not meet the requirements established by the Organizing Committee are not accepted for consideration;
- Abstracts of authors who do not speak at the conference will not be published;
- Abstracts sent to the conference should be sent from the personal e-mail address of each participant, in a Word file with the author's name in the file.

Guideline on Writing Style:

- Text format: Times New Roman, size 12, spacing 1;
- Information about the topic and the author is indicated in the center: the title of the thesis is written in capital letters (Bold), the name and surname of the author should be in bold type (Bold), the institution to which author belongs, academic degree, scientific name and e-mail address;

- Key words must be added to the abstracts (keywords at least five or at most six) Keywords are written in two languages in accordance with the title and content of the report (from 5 to 6);
- Abstract should be between 1000 (minimum) and 3000 (maximum) words (not including translation of the thesis and list of references). The thesis should concisely highlight the main ideas on the topic, relevance, scientific significance, innovations and results;
- Tables and figures given in the appendix to the thesis should be indicated sequentially and named in the format (table 1, table 2; picture 1, picture 2). For example, Table 1. Population of the Republic of Azerbaijan (according to the 1999 census);
- Tables and quotations of the thesis can take only 25% of the total volume. The rest of the thesis should be new ideas and research;
- Bibliography and Internet resources should be arranged alphabetically, with a clear indication of the author, title, year and place of publication, and the total volume of literature. When specifying Internet resources, the author of the cited work, the title of the article or information, the hyperlink and the date of the link are indicated first; Abstracts should be submitted after full editing.
