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Humanitarian-Science Doctorate of Cathedra of History of Georgia***MILITARY GENERALS AND FAMOUS SONS OF BORCHALO REGION,
GEORGIA**

Borchalo (Kvemo Kartli), the region of a rich and great history from ancient period, obtains its public life, literature and artistic environment and oratory; has got famous oriental singers, wise Aghsaqal, famous statesmen, wise and educated sons, military service men, tens of higher rank generals.

It is not accidental that in the world civilization Borchalo people have educated great geniuses for science and art. People grown up on this land have got the right to talk proudly. In each period of history Borchalo people respected government of Georgia, its laws and the flag. They always respected Georgian flag like as Georgian people do. They were fighting against foreign enemies together with the native people. Disputes never were arisen between them.

Turkish and Azerbaijan people, citizens of this country who were living in Georgia never had any problematic situations with Georgian people. Borchalo Turkish people always, in each period of history, had occupied the most reliable positions beside Georgian Kings. We can speak boldly that Borchalo Turkish people can be proud of their work, merits and their dependence towards this land and Georgia itself. As their grandfathers gained trust and faith of Georgian kings, they were working as family cooks and private guards.

If we look into the past, we shall find foundation of military generals among Turkish people, together with famous statesmen and public men. Some of them achieved this level in other countries. They were born in Borchalo.

Among them were: Alimerdan Beg Topchubashov - famous statesman and public man, Nariman Narimanov - writer, publicist, dramaturge and a doctor, Omar Paik Nemanzade - great public man and publicist, Abdula Shaig - great writer and teacher, academic Zahid Khalilov, academic Kamal Talibzade, Military Leaders Bairabrs, General Mayor I. Iadigarov, General Mayor H. Iadigarov, General Mayor A. Ismailov, Zakir Karalov - General Procurator of Azerbaijan, General Akhund Iusif Talibzade, Hajirahim Mamedov, Bekir Dursun Oglu Mustafaev - hero of the Soviet Union, who was awarded the highest rank of the Soviet Union, living in village Vlordzi, Ismail Bairamov - the hero of the Soviet Union from village Sarvani, Borchalo, Mamed Osman Oglu Osmanov, inhabitant of village Akhsuri, Akhaltsikhe region, decorated with Post Soviet Union Lenini order, awarded with two red flag orders, first sort medal of civil war, red star and many other medals, candidate of the Soviet Union hero status, Emrah Kara Oglu Aslanov - acknowledged as to be worthy to get "Honor Order" of all the three sorts, living in village Algeti, Marneuli region, hero Alaz Mamed Oglu Zeinalov from village Sadakhlo and others who raised the name of this land with their heroism.

The above mentioned heroes, notwithstanding where they lived or fought, never forget our country, Georgia and one of its parts, Borchalo. Life of these persons is full with heroism and their past will stay as a model for generations.

The name of Baibars from Borchalo who was governing Egypt state from 1260 till 1277 is worthy to mention with the same proud as of his grandfather's.

We should surely talk about Mehrali PrinBegce from Darvazi acknowledged to be worthy to be awarded with Phasha title, the highest military rank in the whole Turkish territory.

General Mayor Israfil Beg Iadigarov was originated from village Teleki, Borchalo region. Information about his award with the rank of General Mayor was published in "Kavkazski Lider" in 1873-1874.

Hasan Beg Israfil Beg Ogli Iadigarov was generated from the same village and the same family and was acknowledged to be worthy of the General Mayor Rank in the beginning of the XX century. It should be mentioned that in 1854, Hasan Beg Israfil Beg Ogli Iadigarov, born in the mentioned village, was died in 1934. He is buried in village Telek.

Akhund Iusip Talibzade was born in Tbilisi. In 1921-1922 he was working on the position of military commissar with the General rank. He was died in 1923.

Military Leader, General Mayor Aivaz Kara Ogli Ismailov was born in 1927 in village Darvazi, Bolnisi region, Georgia. He participated in the World War II. He was military officer and was awarded with General Mayor Rank. He was died in 2000 in Baku.

General Mayor Hajikerim Samed Ogli Mamedov was born on January 1, 1948 in village Shikhlishi, Tetri Tskaro region, Georgia. In 1967 he was graduated from Marneuli school boarding house.

He finished high military artillery school. He spent most of his life in far west military district.

In 1990 he came to Azerbaijan, actively participated in army formation. In 1994 by the order of Heidar Aliyev was awarded with the General Mayor Rank.

Nowadays he is authorized on the position of the Head of Military Academy of Azerbaijan Armed Forces.

Zakir Bekir Ogli Karalov is a General of Justice. He was born in village Ormesheni, Dmanisi region. Today he is the General Procurator of the Republic of Azerbaijan and III Rank Adviser of the State Justice; He occupies the post of the General Mayor of Justice.

Bairamov Ismail Khalil Ogli was born in 1910 in village Sarvani, Borchalo (now Marneuli) region. He participated in the war. On April 10, 1945 on the base of the Post Soviet Union Highest Council decision he was awarded with the special rank of "Soviet Union Hero" for his heroism on the front.

Mustafaev Bekir Dursun Ogli was born in 1898 in village Blorpza, Akhaltsikhe region, Georgia. On February 16, 1944 on the base of the Post Soviet Union Highest Council decision he was awarded with the special rank of "Soviet Union Hero".

Sadig Beg Iadigar Ogli Iadigarov was born in village Teleki, Borchalo region in famous family of Iadigarov. In 1795 when Aga Mahmad Shakh Kajar attacked Tbilisi, he was fighting for Tbilisi depending together with Borchalo population. He was a friend of Erekle II who sent him as an Ambassador to Fatali Khan from Gubel. His wife was Georgian. They had three sons – Archil Beg, Veli Beg and David Beg. David Beg changed his surname to Iadigarashvili in the Soviet Union period. Until his last years he was living in Zestaponi.

Khudu Beg Iadigarov also was a soldier. He either was a friend of Erekle II. The king trusted to Khudu Beg in most difficult situations. Generally, he retired one Georgian Military Leader and entitled Khudu Beg on this position.

Khudu Beg did his great bit in Georgian fight against foreigners. He is worthy to be talked widely and his name should be mentioned in the history.

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
